University of Missouri researchers find that violent video games do not cause aggression in adults with Autism Spectrum Disorder

A new University of Missouri study may be the beginning of disproving the idea that people with autism spectrum disorders who play violent video games are more likely to commit acts of real-world violence. This assertion gained some traction in the media after the December 2012 mass shooting in Newtown, Connecticut. In the aftermath of the December 2012 shooting at the Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown, Connecticut, the national media focused on shooter Adam Lanza's emotional issues related to suffering from Autism and his exposure to violent video games.

The study, "Effects of Violent Video Game Exposure on Aggressive Behavior, Aggressive Thought , and Aggressive Affect among Adults with and without Autism Spectrum Disorder (PDF), tested the effects of violent video games on aggression in adults with autism spectrum disorder to test levels of aggression in a laboratory setting.

Researchers had study subjects play one of two violent video games (with different levels of violent content) and then asked them to complete a task to test aggression levels. Participants were told by researchers that they were competing against each other; if they "won" they were given the choice of blasting their opponent with a loud noise - with the length and volume of the noise at the control of the "winner." More than 100 adults between the ages of 17 and 25 (half with autism spectrum disorder and half typically developing) participated in the study.

"If violent video games caused adults with autism spectrum disorder to behave aggressively, we should have seen some evidence of this in our study, but we did not," said lead author Christopher Engelhardt, a postdoctoral fellow in the MU School of Health Professions and the MU Thompson Center for Autism and Neurodevelopmental Disorders.

Researchers also concluded that violent video games do not affect adults with autism spectrum disorder differently than "typically developing adults."

Engelhardt does note some caveats with the research:

"There are some caveats to our findings," Engelhardt said. "For example, we only exposed participants to violent or nonviolent games for 15 minutes before measuring their willingness to behave aggressively. This study, therefore, cannot speak to the potential long-term effects of violent-video-game exposure."
